TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The competition will be judged to select, in the opinion of the judges, the best entries in the following three categories:

CATEGORY 1 - Short Story

- Entry Fee \$15 per entry
- First Prize only \$2,000
- Must not exceed 3,000 words

CATEGORY 2 - Contemporary Poetry

- Entry Fee \$15 per entry
- First Prize only \$2,000
- Must not exceed 200 lines



CATEGORY 3 - Children's Writing Awards (16 years and under)

- Entry Fee \$5 per entry
- First Prize \$200, Second Prize \$100, Third Prize \$100
- · Children's Short Story entries must not exceed 1,000 words, or
- Children's Poetry entries must not exceed 30 lines (excluding title)
- Please provide your age as at Friday 5 May 2023 on Entry Form
- · Parent/Carer contact details must be provided for entrants under 18 years of age

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

The awards are aimed at promoting Australian writing and writers. The only requirement is for Australian content

- Entries must be the unaided work of the entrant
- Entrants name must not appear anywhere on the work
- Entries do not have to be written in the same style as the work of Banjo Paterson or in 'bush' style
- Entries previously published will be considered by the judges providing no payment was received
- · If previously published include publishing information (as requested under Entry Details)
- One entry form must be completed for each entry submitted
- Entry forms may be photocopied
- All entries are to be available for reproduction or publication by Orange City Library with copyright being retained by the author
- Winners will be notified by phone on Tuesday, 20 June 2023 and formally announced at the Orange Readers and Writers Festival on Saturday 5 August 2023.
- The list of winners and their winning entries will be available to view on Central West Libraries website www.cwl.nsw.gov.au All winning entries are recorded on theorangewiki.orange.nsw.gov.au
- · When submitting multiple entries, an entry form must be completed for each entry
