About the Banjo Paterson Writing Awards

The Banjo Paterson Writing Awards were established in 1991 and aim to honour Banjo Paterson, a great Australian writer and favourite son of Orange with a competition to foster writing with Australian content. The winners are announced at the Orange Readers and Writers Festival to be held on Saturday 3rd August at the Hotel Canobolas.

There are three categories:

- Children's Writing Awards for children under 16 years of age
- Contemporary Poetry
- Short Story

Selected judges are required to

- Read all entries in their allocated category between April 26 and June 3
- Shortlist entries in their allocated category
- Determine the winning entry in their category
- Write a report on the shortlisted entries in their category

What to include in your Expression of Interest

Submit a cover letter with your resume addressing the following criteria:

- An outline of your interest in the awards
- An overview of your experience in reviewing/judging literature in your area of expertise.
- Read all the works submitted for the competition, make a shortlist and judge winners providing
 a final report
- Highlight any impediments you may have to judging the awards and declare any conflict of interest
- Be an integral part of the well regarded Banjo Paterson Writing Awards Competition
- Be available to meet the timeframe for 2019 Judging as follows:
